Facts	WHAT DOES M.S. HOWELLS & CO. (MSH) DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?
Why?	Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. How?	All financial companies need to share customer’s personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons we can share your personal information, the reasons we share, and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does MSH protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings. Our security practices include limiting access to this information to those employees and business associates with appropriate authority and for intended business purposes only.
How does MSH collect my personal information?	MSH collects your personal information, for example, when you: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Open an account</i> • <i>Provide account information</i> • <i>Make contributions or withdrawals from your account</i> • <i>Seek financial advice</i> • <i>We also collect your personal information from third parties, such as credit bureaus, affiliates, or other companies.</i>

Why can't I limit all sharing?	<p>Federal law gives you the right to limit only:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • <i>Sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes - information about your creditworthiness</i> • <i>Affiliates from using your information to market to you</i> • <i>Sharing for non-affiliates to market to you</i> <p><i>State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing.</i></p>
What happens when I limit sharing for an account that I hold jointly with someone else?	Your choices will apply to everyone on your account.

Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial or non-financial companies. Our affiliates include MSH Capital Advisors LLC and MS Insentra LLC.
Non- Affiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and non-financial companies. Non-affiliates that we share with can include your financial advisor's current and future investment advisory company, clearing firms, custodian firms, and other broker/dealers and investment advisers as designated by your investment advisor should he/she leave MSH or retire.
Joint Marketing	A formal agreement between non-affiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. MSH does not have any joint marketing agreements.
